<p><b>Green level</b></p>	<p>All students who consistently follow school rules remain on this level and enjoy the rights and privileges Raglan Public School has to offer.</p>	
<p><b>Warning level: Blue Level</b></p> <p>Students who receive a blue slip while on green level.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discipline slip sent to parents</li> <li>Student remains on Blue level for 1 week</li> </ul>	<p>Student spends one week on this level.</p> <p>If there are no further offences within the week the student returns to Green Level.</p>
<p><b>Level 1 Demerit: Yellow Level</b></p> <p>Students who receive additional Discipline slips while on Blue level.</p> <p>Or students who receive a level 1 demerit for a more serious offence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Level 1 Demerit letter (Yellow) sent to parents.</li> <li>Interview with classroom teacher and or executive.</li> <li>Interview or discussion with parents.</li> <li>Student attends a one day detention.</li> <li>Exclusion from Big Day Out reward for that term.</li> <li>Consideration for loss of school privileges or representation for the time period of this level.</li> </ul>	<p>Student spends one week on this level.</p> <p>If there are no further offences within the one week the student returns to Green Level.</p>
<p><b>Level 2 Demerit: Orange Level</b></p> <p>Students who show no consistent improvement in behavior while on yellow level.</p> <p>Or students who receive a level 2 demerit for a more serious offence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Level 2 Demerit letter (Orange) sent to parents.</li> <li>Interview with classroom teacher and or executive.</li> <li>Formal interview with parents.</li> <li>Student attends a two day detention.</li> <li>Exclusion from Big Day Out reward for that term.</li> <li>Consideration for loss of school privileges or representation for the time period of this level.</li> <li>Participation in excursions reviewed by LST.</li> </ul>	<p>Student spends two weeks on this level.</p> <p>If there are no further offences within the two weeks the student returns to Green Level.</p>
<p><b>Level 3: Demerit: Red level</b></p> <p>Students who show no consistent improvement in behavior while on orange level.</p> <p>Or students who receive a level 3 demerit for a more serious offence.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Level 3 Demerit letter (Red) sent to parents.</li> <li>Interview with classroom teacher and or executive.</li> <li>Formal interview with parents.</li> <li>Student attends a three day detention.</li> <li>Exclusion from Big Day Out reward for that term.</li> <li>Consideration for loss of school privileges or representation for the time period of this level.</li> <li>Consideration for long or short suspension – parents provided with warning.</li> <li>Participation in excursions reviewed by LST.</li> </ul>	<p>Student spends three weeks on this level.</p> <p>If there are no further offences within the three weeks the student returns to Green Level.</p>
<p><b>Suspension level</b></p>	<p>Student is suspended from school according to DEC Suspension policy.</p> <p>Upon completion of suspension student is placed on Level 3 and then follows Level 3 procedures.</p>
