Reece Urquhart and Tom Smith are to be congratulated for their excellent listening skills and both received a prize to thank them. Well done Tom and Reece.



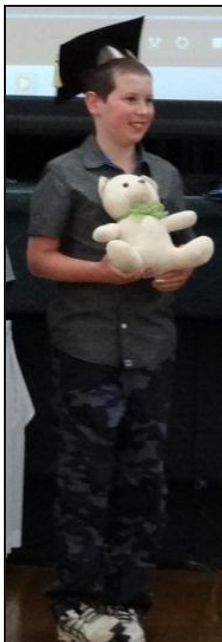
### WINNERS OF THE CLASS SHIELD
