Registration Day is on Saturday 7th December at Brooke Moore Oval between 10.30am -1pm, or ring Matthew Tabbernor on 0425 297 719.

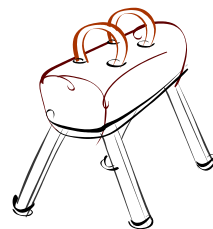
