The Junior Girls relay team came first in their race as did Nikki Browne, Emily Browne and Emilee Curran in their various races.

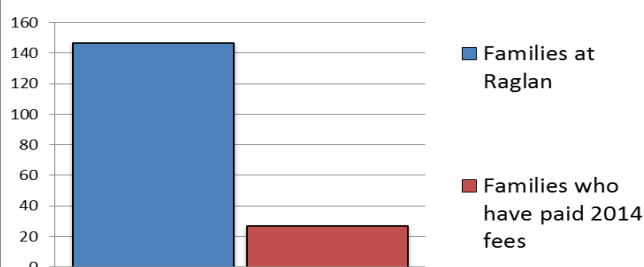
