Principals Report Cyberbullying

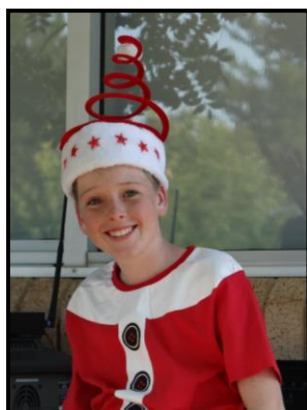
