Bathurst and District Junior Touch Football Competition.

We are looking for Boy, Girl or Mixed Junior touch football teams. Divisions include U10's, 12's and 14's. Under 16's play as a junior team in the senior competition.

Venue: to be held at Learmonth Park from 4.30pm each Monday for 30 minute games.

Starts: 27 Oct 2015. **Finishes:** 29 Feb 2016 (with a break over Christmas).

Nomination period: opens 24 Sept to 19 Oct 2015 – team registrations can be completed online at: bathurst-touch-football.asn.au

Cost: \$260 per team. Please note there is a minimum of 6 players (usually 10 player sides). For under 16 teams playing in the senior competition nomination fees are \$570 per team.

Coach: each team requires a coach/manager who can also referee. The cost of the referee course is free. Those persons wishing to do the referee course should contact David Weekes on 0439 321 568.

Age: age divisions are based on players turning that age during 2015. For example, if you turn 12 in 2015 you can play in the U12's division.
